Escape from your routine! Bring comfy shoes for hiking the wooden swamp trails, climbing the viewing towers and exploring the cycle paths.




Jurmala


Ligatne

The cobbled streets and tiled roofs of the old town aren't the only medieval remnants here. Grab a lantern and explore one of the most impressive castle ruins in Latvia!




Aglona Basilica

This family-friendly city is well known for its cow sculptures, white sand beaches, amusement parks and narrow-gauge railway at the open-air museum.




Baltic Sea Coast

From white sand beaches to rugged sandstone cliffs to secluded pebble beaches, find your favourite part of our 500 km-long coastline!




Traditional Festivities
